

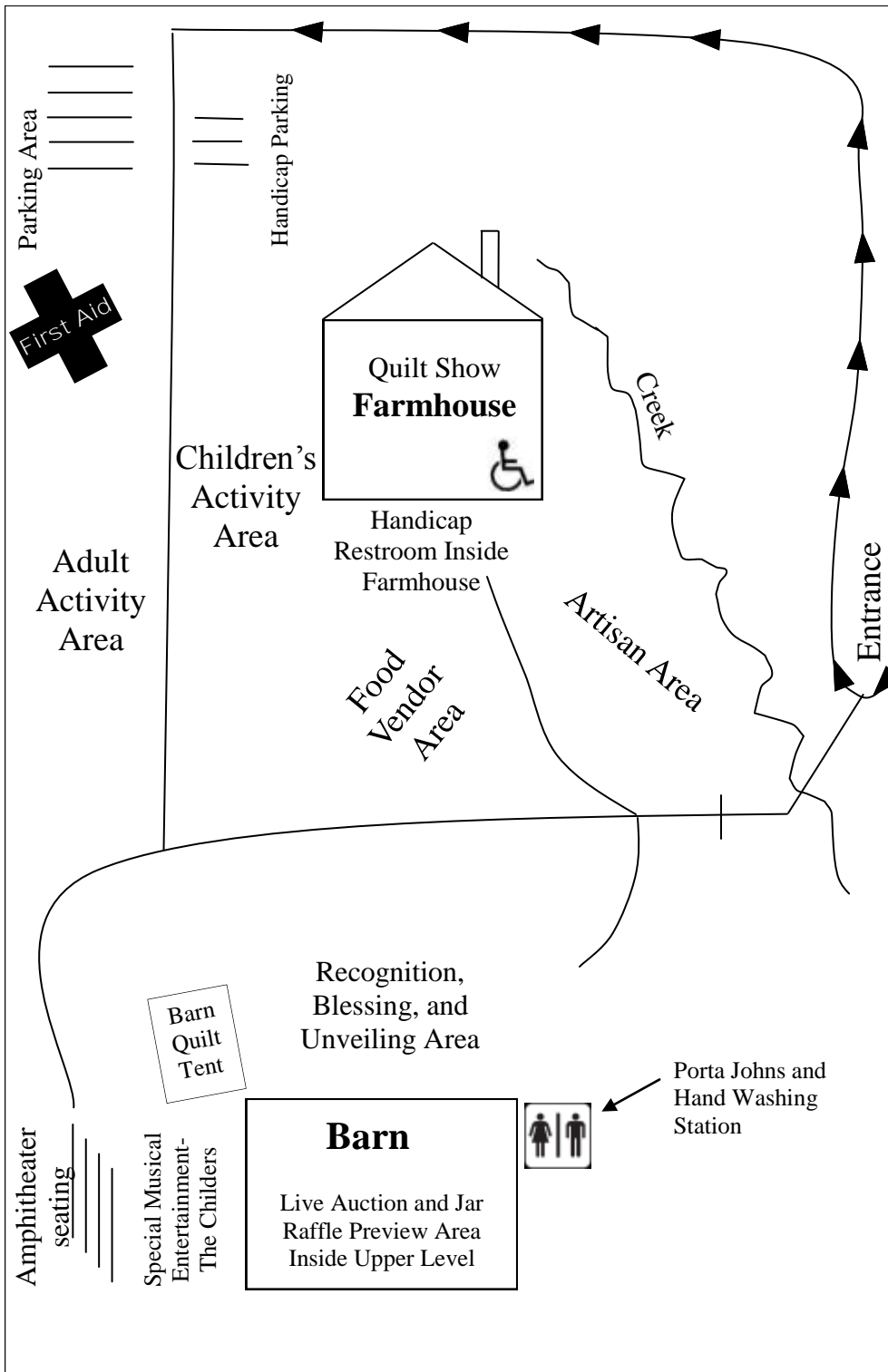


Second Annual Barn Quilt Festival

An Expanding Barn Quilt Trail

Donna Sue Groves, a native Appalachian, purchased a farm that included an old tobacco barn. To honor her mother, an avid quilter, Donna Sue came up with the idea to have a quilt block painted on the old structure. Barn Quilts began from this idea in Adams County, Ohio. It was nearly 12 years before her own barn quilt was painted, but Donna Sue did indeed fulfill her promise and much more. It was the beginning of a barn quilt trail that in just 10 years winds through 30 states and 2 Canadian provinces.

To celebrate the 10th anniversary of this project, the *Quilt Trail Gathering—Celebrating a Decade* was organized to bring together the organizers of quilt trails around the country to share stories and information with each other. As part of that celebration volunteers from three counties in Ohio put together, with funding support from the Ohio State Arts Council, a large quilt to use as the stage back drop. The Barn Quilt Association of Garrett County is honored to display this quilt as the backdrop for our live auction.

Below is a diagram of the large quilt block names. In addition to the talented people who created each quilt square, credit goes to Mary Ellen Briggs, Donna Sue Groves, Maxine Groves, Carol Phipps, and Ann Taylor for the borders, sashing and finishing.

The **STORY QUILT** of Russ and Barb Childers takes you on an interactive, musical journey of the imagination. Audiences discover family stories, proverbs and word play, folk beliefs and folkways - but especially the stories, songs, dances, and games from Appalachian traditions.

In the past, the fabrics that made up a handmade quilt often came from bits and pieces of a family's discarded clothing. If those scraps could talk, what memories would they reveal for today's child?
